STURGIS MAN CONVICTED

Frank J. Manley Guilty of Murdering
Richard Cheney a Year Ago.

STURGIS, Mich., March 3.—Frank J. Manley, who murdered Richard Cheney March 30, 1916, was found guilty of manslaughter by a jury today. The jury, was instructed by Judge Knowlton Friday, went out at 10:30 and reached an agreement at 5 o'clock Saturday morning. He will be sentenced Monday.

Manley, it was charged, killed Cheney in a quarrel, and pleaded self-defense.
