

J. FRANK MANLEY GETS THREE YEARS

SLAYER OF RICHARD CHENEY
SENT TO JACKSON FOR
THREE YEARS.

Three Rivers, March 13. ---J. Frank Manley, who was recently tried the second time for the shooting of Richard Cheney nearly a year ago, was sentenced Saturday evening about 5 o'clock. There had been some talk of a new trial by Manley's attorneys, but, on being asked his preference Mr. Manley stated that he had received a fair trial and preferred his sentence. He was sentenced to a period of from three to fifteen years at Jackson with a recommendation of five years.
