

JUROR'S BREAKDOWN HALTS MURDER TRIAL

WILLIAM DILLON TAKEN SERIOUSLY ILL AT HEARING IN
CENTERVILLE

Centerville, Nov. 28.—The J. Frank Manley trial was resumed at Centerville this afternoon.
